L.I.F.E.-based Service

The L.I.F.E.-based service is a new CLBC service that was piloted in five locations throughout BC and will now be offered in Port Alberni by PAACL.

L.I.F.E. = Learning, Inclusion, Friendship & Employment

The L.I.F.E.-based service combines support for people interested in employment who also want to connect to their community, pursue life-long learning, and build meaningful relationships. The L.I.F.E.-based service measures the difference it makes in a person's life beyond achieving goals.



A Flexible & Responsive Service

The L.I.F.E.-based service is provided in community and occurs when and where the person's goals will best be achieved. It is a flexible and responsive service that offers support when it's needed and not when it's not. The L.I.F.E.-based service is not about hours spent with a person, but rather about receiving the right support when you need it and using personalized approaches for planning and evaluation to make it happen.
