Personalized Supports Initiative (PSI)

The Personalized Supports Initiative (PSI) was introduced by Community Living BC to provide supports to adults who have both significant limitations in day to day functioning or adaptive functioning and either a diagnosis of Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) or Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD).

PSI is intended to augment rather than replace existing supports. The goal of this program is to help individuals increase or maintain their independence. Community Support Workers work closely with individuals to create a personalized plan based on their identified needs. Referrals to the PSI program are made solely through Community Living BC.

The Port Alberni Association for Community Living will now be providing PSI services in our community.
